## This Week's Mission Focus: Across the Street

### *Irmo, South Carolina: Sharing God's Love*

Sharing God's Love (SGL) is a local cooperative ministry that provides area families in need with food, clothing, help with utilities, and spiritual support.

Established in 1984, SGL was founded by representatives of churches in St. Andrews, Ballentine, and Dutch Fork who identified a need for a central location where community families facing emergencies related to their basic living requirements could be served. The mission of SGL has not changed since, serving on average 230 families in need each week. The excitement and enthusiasm which prevailed at the beginning of this ministry continues to grow, and blessings abound for those who serve, as well as those who are served.

God has blessed SGL with amazing ministry partners, like St. Andrews Presbyterian Church. Through their collaborative partnerships, they were able to serve over 5500 individuals in 2017, with over \$698,000 in assistance given. SGL was also able to help other local ministries serve their community through resource partnerships. What a blessing!
