**This Week's Mission Focus: Across the Street**

**Presbyterian Evangelistic Fellowship (PEF): One Church Ablaze**

*Tim Hanley, Midlands*

The Presbyterian Evangelistic Fellowship, (PEF) is a nonprofit faith mission whose purpose is to practice, train, and equip God's people to do biblical evangelism, anywhere, anytime, with anyone. The U.S. team is spread across many states, and the international team labors in twenty-five nations.

After serving as assistant pastor at Chapin Presbyterian Church (PCA), Tim Hanley and his wife Deb began to minister with One Church Ablaze in the South Carolina Midlands through revival prayer, revival preaching, and evangelism. *"How many churches are there in the Midlands? 400? 600? 800? Actually, there is only ONE! That is the ONE Church of the Lord Jesus. Just like there were many expressions of the One Church in Ephesus, in Corinth, in Colossae, and in Rome, there is just ONE Church in the Midlands of South Carolina. And the Lord Jesus' will is for that ONE Church to be ablaze with the Holy Spirit—to be aglow and burning with the Spirit, serving the Lord (Romans 12:11, AMP)."*

For two years, Tim has struggled with sciatica resulting in major back surgery. Though relieved somewhat, painful neuropathy and sciatica continued. Tim has spent much time in prayer, mentoring, and ministering to the Church and many pastors, often from a prone position. Recently, *"the Lord has led me to a medication that immediately and significantly relieved my pain. Praise His Name and thanks for praying. I am doing so much better and feel like a new man!"*

Please continue to **pray** that the Lord would give Tim compassion for the lost in our communities and that He would raise up others who will co-labor with him.
