Germany: Gospel Church München

Sam & Elizabeth Goodwin; daughters: Katie, Sophie, and Molly

Sam & Lizzie Goodwin serve with Mission to the World (MTW) as church planters in Munich, Germany. They are longtime SAPC members and were sent out by SAPC in November 2012. For the past 12 months, they have been in the States on Home Ministry Assignment (HMA) visiting their many churches and supporters, and raising the additional support needed to return to their ministry and calling. They are returning to Munich on Tuesday, August 28!

The Goodwins share:

*German culture is highly secularized and suspicious of religion. Building relationships to gain people's trust is a foundational aspect of our ministry. Our team has joined Gospel Church München, a small missionary-led church in Munich, in the hopes of forming a Reformed denomination with other churches in Germany. We have started a Bible study for wives of men in the church, some of whom are not yet believers. Because of the trust and friendship these women have developed, they are increasingly open to learning about the Bible.*

*When we return to Munich, Sam will continue to serve Gospel Church München. His language fluency continues to improve, and he will be teaching and discipling more. Lizzie will be focusing more on teaching, mentoring, translation and discipleship.*

**Pray for wisdom** to stay calm and to follow the Lord's calling for the new challenges and opportunities that await us after being away for a year.

**Pray for our daughters, Katie, Sophie, and Molly,** as they leave American friends and family to return to Germany. This year's frequent travel has been tough on them, but they have shown remarkable resilience to serve with their parents.

**Pray** that we will build in more times of rest and family time and consciously keep from being swept up in the maelstrom of needs.


And **pray** that our additional support needs will be funded.

## BIOGRAPHY OF BOB BRYANT

Bob was born and raised in the St. Andrews area of Columbia. His parents were founding members of Seven Oaks Presbyterian Church in the 1960s. During his high school years, his family left Seven Oaks Presbyterian to help form Saint Andrews Presbyterian (of which he and his wife are charter members.)

After graduating from Irmo High School, Bob earned a B.S. in Financial Management (with an accounting emphasis) from Clemson University. Bob met Betsy, who would become his wife, during high school. They married just before his last year at Clemson.

After college, Bob & Betsy moved back to Columbia to take jobs; he at Arthur Andersen & Co. as a staff accountant and she at Newberry County Schools as a teacher. They attended SAPC and served in many different capacities. In 1993, Bob, a CPA and a registered securities principal, left Arthur Andersen to start his own financial services firm in Irmo, which is affiliated with Raymond James. He is still working in that capacity full-time.

In 1997, Bob & Betsy had their first of four girls and Betsy became a stay-at-home mom. They are currently very busy parents seeking to raise their (mostly teenaged) girls in a Christian home, under the Lordship of Christ.

Bob was licensed to preach in the Palmetto Presbytery in 2016. In 2017, he completed a Masters of Divinity (MDiv) from LAMP Seminary and began working part-time as an assistant to the pastor at Saint Andrews Presbyterian Church, where his responsibilities include member enfoldng, community groups, and other general pastoral duties. Also in 2017, he enrolled at Westminster Theological Seminary's Doctor of Ministries (DMin) program in counseling.
